Habitat at the Bengel Wildlife Center is divided into two types of management areas: wetland and upland. Each management area is outlined on the map. The numbers following the wetland (wm) or upland (um) management designation indicate techniques that will be used on that area.

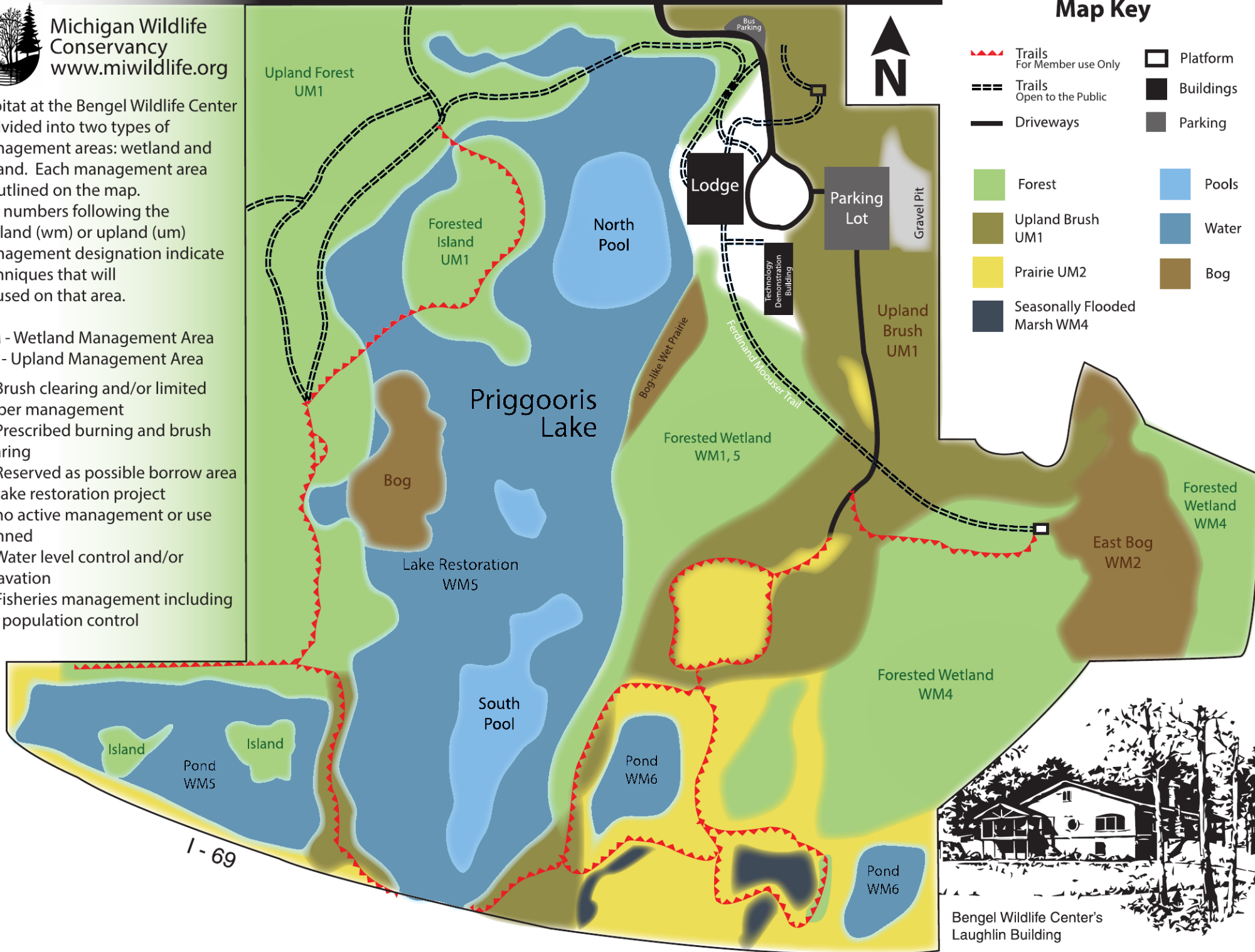
WM - Wetland Management Area  
UM - Upland Management Area

- 1 - Brush clearing and/or limited timber management
- 2 - Prescribed burning and brush clearing
- 3 - Reserved as possible borrow area for lake restoration project
- 4 - no active management or use planned
- 5 - Water level control and/or excavation
- 6 - Fisheries management including fish population control
